HOMILY

Samuel is certainly one of the main figures in the Old Testament. He lives in a time of great religious and political change. The Philistines, a strong and well-armed people, have occupied the plains, pushing Israel back into the less fertile mountains. All the Jewish tribes decide to come together and choose a strong and courageous king, to organize and lead them into battle against this powerful, aggressive and greedy neighbour.

The passage from undisciplined tribal life to an organized monarchy is a difficult and uneasy period. Samuel is called to communicate the will of God to the people as they go through this delicate constitutional change. All know and appreciate him because he goes from town to town to enforce justice and pronounce impartial sentences, to advise those in power and what is more important, to speak in the name of God. Nobody takes decisions before consulting him, and when the first king is chosen Samuel will be the one to consecrate him.

The first reading presents us Samuel as a child living in the temple of the Lord at Shiloh and helping the priest Eli. One night he heard a voice calling him. Not knowing where the voice came from, he ran to Eli who understood that God must have some heavenly message to communicate. He taught young Samuel that he must listen to the message of God. When God calls, a person must say, "Speak, Yahweh, for your servant is listening."

This Passport must be signed every Sunday to indicate the candidate has been to Mass. The programme will commence on Tuesday 30th January 2018. The first parents' evening will be on Tuesday 23rd January 2018 at 8:00pm.
